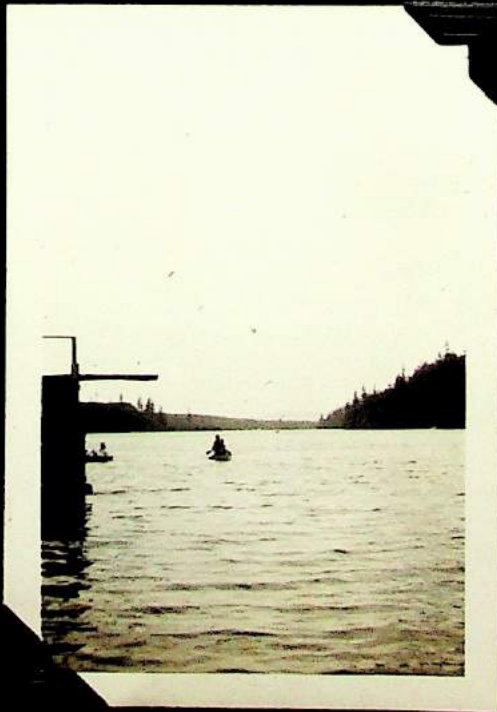

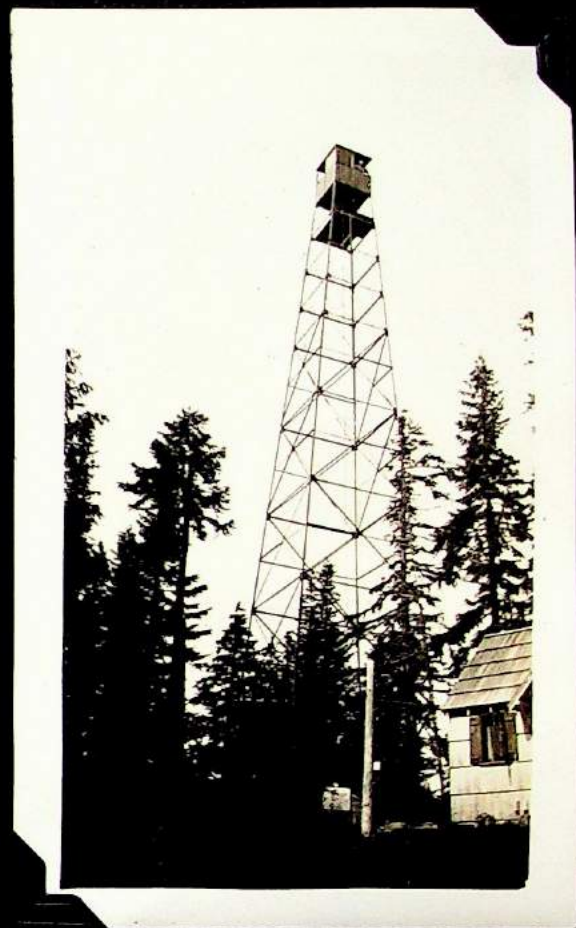
Larch Mountain Trip

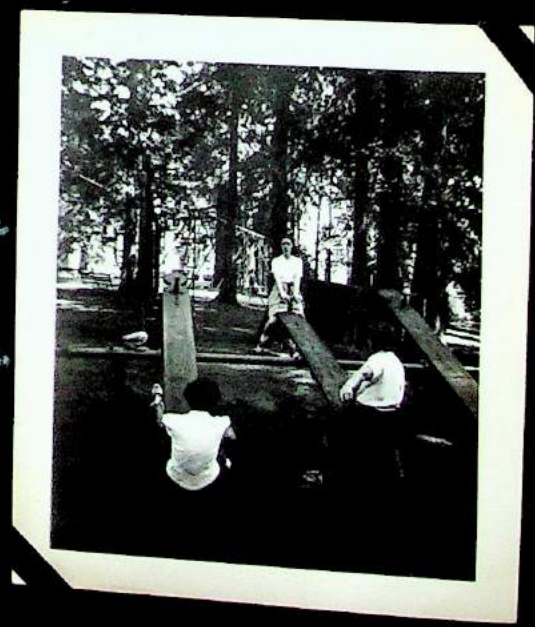
Washington Park April 13-

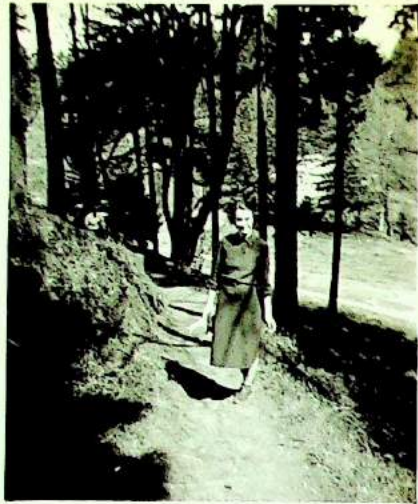

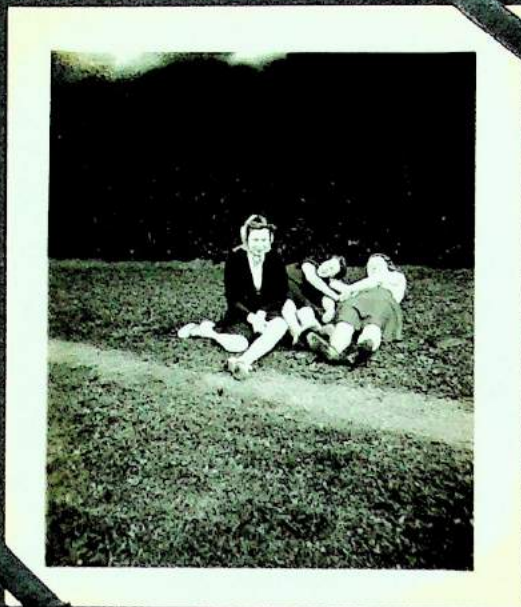

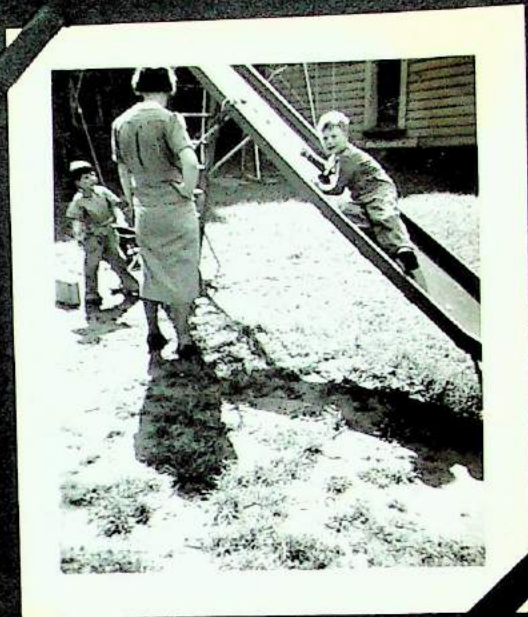

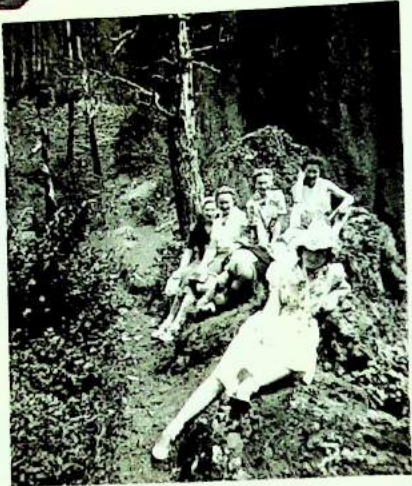

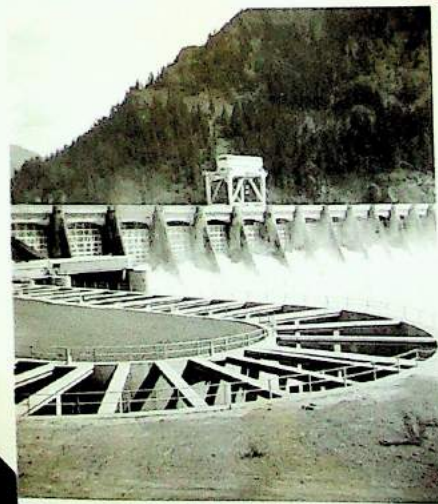

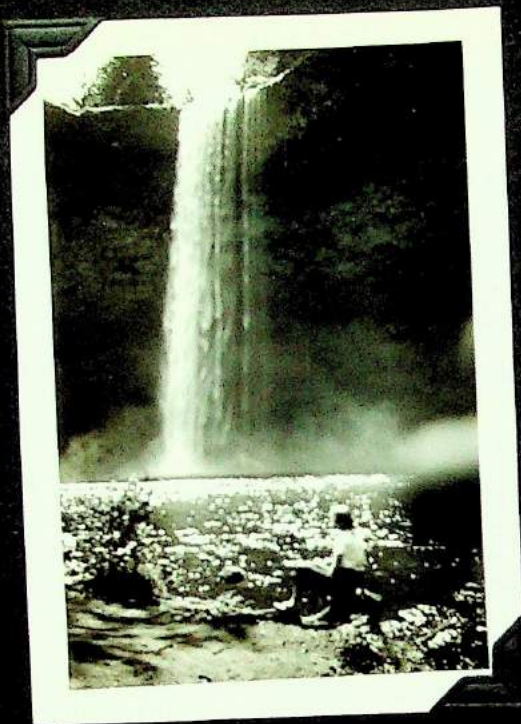
